DESCRIPTION:

This position reports to the Head of Public Services in the Health Sciences Library. The major responsibilities are in the areas of reference, instruction and faculty liaison services. The successful applicant will participate in the planning, design, and delivery of innovative instruction sessions, reference services, promotion and liaison with faculty, collection development, and other library service duties. Some evening and weekend work will be required.

The Health Sciences Library serves the faculty, staff and students of Memorial University's Faculty of Medicine, and Schools of Nursing and Pharmacy, and the staff and students of the Health Sciences Centre site of the Eastern Regional Health Authority. The Library also supports the information needs of health care professionals throughout the province of Newfoundland and Labrador. The Health Sciences Library is committed to supporting education, clinical practice and research in health care through the teaching of information skills.

An appointment at the rank of Librarian I is anticipated. Salary is based on experience and qualifications. The salary floor-for Librarian I is \$54,190 as of September 1, 2011.
